Apply Early, Space is Limited

The International League Against Epilepsy (ILAE) has created the Leadership Development Award to support the preparation and advancement of young physicians leaders selected from ILAE and International Bureau for Epilepsy (IBE) chapters around the world.

Award Description:

The Leadership Development Program is a unique and exclusive opportunity to receive leadership development training and network with rising leaders from around the globe. In 2017, the program's second year, approximately 30 candidates will be selected to participate.

Session topics will include: The Science of Communication, Strategic Planning, Conflict Resolution & Negotiation, Planning and Management of Operational Budgets, Management Essentials, Assessing and Leveraging Your Leadership Style, and Opportunities to Lead within ILAE and IBE.

Awardees will be provided:

- Admission to the 32nd International Epilepsy Congress (IEC) in Barcelona, from September 2^{nd-}6th 2017:
- 2. Admission to the invitation only leadership face to face development training course September 2nd-3rd, 2017;
- 3. Lunch with ILAE President and executive leaders;
- 4. Brief afternoon social with leadership alumni; and a
- 5. Certificate of completion.

Limited travel and lodging support will be available for some awardees.

Submission Requirements:

Interested applicants are required to submit the following items:

- 1. Brief statement describing why you are interested in the program and how you would benefit from participation;
- 2. Abbreviated CV; and
- 3. Letter of support from an ILAE or IBE Chapter or Regional Commission leader.

Applications should be submitted electronically to leaders@ilae.org as a .pdf file no later than April 3rd, 2017, and will be accepted on a rolling admissions basis.

Eligibility

Any current, active ILAE or IBE Member is welcome to apply. Strong preference will be given to young leaders. Please note, this program seeks to support rising leaders contributing to ILAE or IBE.
