Dr. McCormick is consultant in pediatric neurorehabilitation and epilepsy at King's College Hospital in London, UK. He participates in a large inpatient and outpatient pediatric epilepsy service, including epilepsy surgery.

Dr. McCormick has experience with VNS since 1995, having attended to more than 200 children implanted with VNS at King's College Hospital. He has lectured extensively on VNS, and has contributed to several large multicenter VNS studies. He has been among the first pediatricians in Europe to implant the AspireSR device. His ongoing interests include the impact of VNS therapy on seizure control, cognitive function and quality of life, as well as acute neurorehabilitation after brain injury.
